Play During Reserved Court Times

Arriving players should note the order of player arrival and first-comers should make up foursomes to play on the unoccupied courts. When there are players waiting, sets should be played on the short game basis.

Waiting players should choose partners from players whose sets have ended. Choice can be made on any basis that is acceptable to the players. If there are still players waiting when all courts are occupied, they will be first in line to choose partners when a game finishes.

There may still be players arriving while the above is happening. These later arrivals must determine their positions in line and wait for their turn to play.

The John Williams trophy is administered by the Grant Connell Tennis Centre and is presented each year to the junior player (12-18 yrs) who exhibits exemplary dedication, work ethic and sportsmanship in tennis. The fifth annual presentation of the John Williams Trophy was awarded to Arisha Ladhani, currently ranked #2 in BC in girls under 18. She recently was a finalist in doubles in the under 18 Indoor National Championships and is starting to play ITF tournaments world-wide.

A Davis Cup Story (John H. Kennedy)

One hundred years ago, in 1913, Canada reached the Davis Cup semi-finals. In 2013 they did it again. Good thing that patience is a Canadian virtue.

Over a three-day weekend in April, Canada faced Italy in a quarter-final match and the weekend went like this:

- Friday April 5: Pospisil (108) vs Seppi (21). Pospisil wins the first two sets, loses the next two and fights hard to take the fifth and deciding set, but cannot overcome Seppi. Good match and Pospisil looks drained at the end.
- Later the same day: Raonic (16) vs Fognini (25). Three hard-fought sets and Raonic emerges a winner. The serve is on. Down the line power works. The crosscourt verges on the magical. Fognini gets close every now and again but not close enough.
- Saturday April 6: Pospisil, who seemed exhausted after yesterday's match is teamed up with Nestor (doubles rank 8) against Bracciali (doubles rank 23) and Fognini. Unlike the Spanish doubles match a

few months earlier, Pospisil and Nestor look like they were a team. They took the first two sets. Crowd is excited. I'm thinking, have I seen this before? Our guys lose the next two sets. Then the magic begins again. Win one lose one over and over again. There's no tie break in Davis Cup. The fifth set ends up at 15-13 with Pospisil serving steadily and sometimes brilliantly and Nestor playing up to his reputation.

• Sunday April 7: Raonic vs Seppi. Canada leads 2-1 in games and to win takes three points so we have to win one of today's scheduled matches. The crowd is excited but you can feel the tension in the stands. Raonic pulls it off: 6-4, 6-4, 3-6, 7-5. Canada is in the semi-finals for the first time in one hundred years.

• We meet Serbia on September 13-15 in Belgrade. Turn on your TV and cheer them on!

At Norm's suggestion I tried to contact Jose on Tuesday June 4th to play on Thursday and his daughter Margaret answered the phone and gave me the tragic news that Jose had passed away on Friday, May 31st.

It was a shock to all of us tennis friends.

He always greeted people senior or senora with a smile and I will sorely miss that morning greeting Senior Elmer.

He will be remembered as a gracious gentleman and an avid tennis player and friend. He will be missed by us all and we extend our deepest sympathy to his family.


