Play during Reserved Court Times. Arriving players should note the order of player arrival and first-comers should make up foursomes to play on unoccupied courts. When there are players waiting sets should be played on the short game basis. Waiting players should choose partners from players whose sets have ended. Choice can be made on any basis acceptable to players. If there are still players waiting when all courts are occupied, they will be first in line to choose partners when a game finishes. There may still be players arriving while this is happening. Later arrivals must determine their positions in line and wait for their turn to play.

She and I had lots of trips which were always fun and the only rule we obeyed was a requisite gin and tonic at bedtime.


