In the mid '80s she was the driving force behind the creation of the Senior Tennis Association of the North Shore – popularly known as **STANS.** Sitting through endless, boring Council Meetings, she managed to convince the City and District of North Vancouver and West



Vancouver to provide tennis courts to be set aside for seniors as she stated that this generation of seniors is far more active and will keep playing tennis until they are 80, which will keep them healthy and out of hospital....BRAVO, PAT!! Today there are many STANS players well up in the 80s still playing tennis.

Along with a few other dedicated colleagues, she played an important role in obtaining the Indoor Tennis Facility which we all enjoy today.

She was a great organizer, who planned many group vacations for STANS players. Everyone always enjoyed these holidays, which took a lot of time and planning on her part.
