#### PRESIDENT'S REPORT

Leo Dear

I joined the STANS Executive at the March 25, 2003 AGM. At our AGM which will be held on April 15, 2009 I will have served on the Executive for 6 years. I will then retire as required by our Constitution.

Unfortunately, because of the operations on both my eyes I have not been able to see well enough to play tennis the last 2 winters. However I hope to be able to return to tennis on the outdoor courts this coming summer. I have missed playing and will have a lot of catch-up to do this year.

At our March 4th meeting STANS Treasurer Kurt Peiffer reported that on February 28th we had \$5,751.31 in our current account. There are outstanding liabilities at this time that can easily be paid from this account. Kurt will provide full details at the AGM. In addition there is \$5,046.57 in our Term Deposit.

Kurt will retire from the Executive at the April AGM as he will have served 7 years, having been authorized to serve an extra year at our AGM on April 8, 2008. Kurt has carefully managed STANS finances over the years and has truly earned our thanks for a job well done.

STANS Membership Director Will Phillips reported that our present membership numbers are 212 Active members (many of whom have not yet renewed), 15 Life members and 5 Corporate members. Thanks go to Ian Dirom for recruiting the Racket Shack on lower Lonsdale as our 5th Corporate member.

My thanks go to John Kennedy for his sterling efforts in always producing such interesting and informative Newsletters and to Ian Dirom for his successful management of the Summer and Winter programs. Thanks to Kirsty Milligan and Katalin De Korompay for handling the Secretarial, Publicity and Social tasks so competently, to Will Phillips for his organised approach on the Membership file and to Alf Orr for accepting responsibility as our new Treasurer.

We asked the Tennis Directors of the GCTC, WVTC and NSWC for names of talented junior players who will benefit from grants of \$500. All have responded so we will seek membership approval at the AGM to award 3 grants in 2009.

I have thoroughly enjoyed my time on STANS Executive. I've had the pleasure of working with several talented and dedicated members who share the same enthusiasm for STANS. We have not had the demanding work load performed by the early STANS Executives, but we believe our efforts have continued to "enhance the enjoyment of life...of active senior tennis players"; one of the key aims set out in the STANS Constitution.

Finally, I urge you to attend the Wednesday, April 15th AGM at the West Van Seniors' Centre. We will need your input and advice on some of the matters that will be on the agenda. If any of you have not renewed your membership for 2009, you will be able to do so at the AGM.

## MEMBERSHIP RENEWAL & FUTURE NEWSLETTERS




The executive of STANS is grateful to retiring members Leo Dear and Kurt Peiffer for their dedication

#### **GRANTS FOR YOUNG PLAYERS - UPDATE**

Here's an update on the young players to whom STANS gave grants in 2008. Filip Peliwo played in Florida in December and reached the quarter-finals in the Eddie Herr tournament and later in the month, the semifinals in the Junior Orange Bowl, Boys 14 category. Steffi Gjine has been sidelined from tennis for the past six months due to injuries she sustained in an automobile accident. Just weeks ago she finally returned to the courts at the University of North Carolina, played two matches and happily managed to beat her opponents in straight sets. Arisha Ladhani recently finished #2 in the U14 Provincial selection cup to qualify for the national championships. Her win puts her on the Tennis BC squad that will compete at the U14 indoor Nationals in Edmonton in April. She has also been accepted into the Sentinel High School Super Achievers program in September that will give her additional training time. She continues to be a straight "A" student

Again this year, tennis coaches on the North Shore have named up-and-coming junior tennis players who would benefit from the grants we give each year. They have proposed three candidates and we will seek member approval for all or some of the nominees at the Annual General Meeting on Wednesday April 15th.


