Frank lost in straight sets and it seemed a bit anti-climactic after Friday's brilliant win but Frank was still glowing from that one.

Very likely, there will be 3 more indoor courts added at Grant Connell later this year for a for total of 9.

Consideration will be given to increasing STAN's group booking to 4 courts, depending on the interest.

(NOTE: Grant Connell stipulates that no one group can book more than 50% of available courts: 3 now and 4 later with expansion)

### CHRISTMAS SOCIAL AND TENNIS EVENT

Last December's social event was held in Grant Connell and was quite successful with an impressive increase in numbers, both players and guests.

Next December we may be booking five courts instead of four because of the increased interest.
