#### **GRANTS TO YOUNG PLAYERS UPDATE.**

#### Kyryll Kryvchun

Kyryll has been on a roll the last 5 months. This August he became the National under sixteen champion winning both singles and doubles. His ITF world ranking has climbed from #1800 to #580. This summer he had the opportunity to play as a wildcard in the Kelowna men's ITF futures event as well as the Odlum Brown ATP men's Challenger event at Hollyburn, gaining valuable experience playing against players ranked in the top 300 in the world. Kyryll and his coach are now in Atlanta for an ITF event this week and next week they will be in South Carolina.

He and his coach have expressed their appreciation of STANS support which helps them defray part costs of their Junior Circuit travel expenses. They look for our continued support.

#### <u>Alli Valk</u>

This past summer and fall she played in many tournaments in BC and Canada as well as the Pacific Northwest. She won the U16 National Qualifier at Stanley Park, defeating the top three girls from Alberta. She also played her first pro event at the Odlum Brown at Hollyburn.

She has been accepted to compete in the prestigious Eddie Herr tournament in Florida. She has also entered in the Orange Bowl and American Cup in Florida in late November and December.

Her father encourages Alli and is very supportive. He has expressed his thanks for STANS support, which hopes will continue.

#### Luka Vukuvic

Luka is currently the #1 Ranked player in BC U12. He is ranked in the top 15 of U14 as well. In the last U16 Provincial tournament, he got to the semifinals. He will be continuing to train all Fall/Winter with a view to qualify for the Indoor National Championships in April. He and his coach are appreciative of STANS support, which they hope will continue.

#### Vasek Pospisil


Vernon's Vasek Pospisil is the 2013 Vancouver Open men's champion, as he topped Great Britain's Daniel Evans 6-0, 1-6, 7-5 in the final at Hollyburn Country Club for his fourth career ATP Challenger Tour title. He now ranks 32 in ATP Tour ranking.

He nearly beat Roger Federer in the semis in October at ATP 500 event in Switzerland. His partnership with Daniel Nestor is taking Canada closer to winning a grand slam doubles championship.
